- Team registration payments must be received by MCUSA by October 3rd**

TEAM APPLICATION INFORMATION

- Applications will close as age brackets are filled on a first come, first served basis
- Team fee is payable at time application is accepted by Visa, MasterCard, Discover card, check or money order. Payment by credit card requires an additional 3% charge.
- Credit card payment is the only payment method that will secure a position into the tournament at time of application. Those teams paying by check or money order will be placed on a "reserve" basis until payment clears. Note that checks must be postmarked by September 30th, 2011 and received by MCUSA by October 3rd, 2011 to be accepted.**
